Trapper Training School

District 8 of the PA Trappers Association will be holding a trapper training school at Richfield Sportsmans Club on Saturday, August 11, 2018.

This school is designed to help the beginner as well as the advanced trapper. The school will be open to male and female students of all ages and can be a family event. An adult must accompany children under the age of 12. The school is free to anyone who wishes to attend.

Trapping school is a one day, all day long, Saturday session. The school will start at 8:00 a.m. Saturday morning and wrap up around 5:00 p.m. (You need to registered by 7:30 a.m.) Meals will be provided (Breakfast starts at 7:00 a.m. and we will serve lunch).

We have experienced instructors. They will share with you many years of information in a short period of time, so please bring a notebook with you. They will cover the entire trapping process; types of traps, trap preparation, trapping demonstrations on both land and water sets, skinning, fleshing and getting your catch to the fur buyer or tannery. We will also discuss trapping laws, license and seasons.

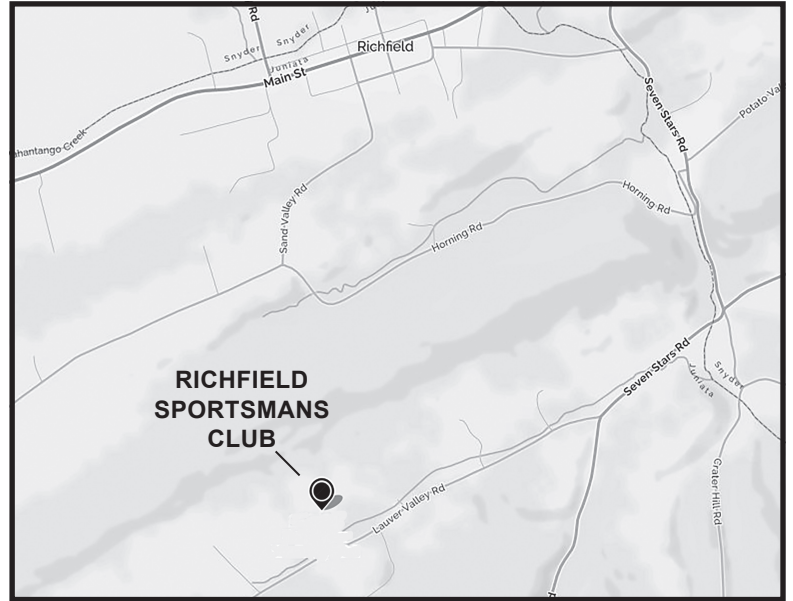

In the town of Richfield, Juniata County.
Off route 35 turn onto seven stars road
at the county line (opposite side of 35).
Seven stars road is curvy road. Continue
approximately 1 mile, the road will make
a hard right and cross a small creek (big
wicket house sits on the bend). Take
the first road on your right, this is Lauver
Valley Road. Go approximately 3/8 mile.
The club is on your right.
